

Department of Justice Reveals How Robinson Gave Himself Away

Washington, D. C., Oct. 17.—The Department of Justice

sued the following statement today concerning the Stoll kidnaping:
During the early evening of October 10, 1931, the divis-

Indianapolis, Oct. 17 (INS)-Department of Justice agents swarmed to 2735 North Meridian Street here today and began a minute examination of a four-room apartment in Lafayette Court, said to have been occupied by Mrs. Berry V.
